1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to respondents to extend the benefit of step up of pay at par with their juniors by removing anomaly in terms of order dated 22.08.2019 (Annexure P-5).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the outset, submits that grievance of the petitioners, at this stage, would be redressed if respondents are directed to decide their legal notice dated 20.11.2024 (Annexure P-7) in a time bound manner.
3. Mr. Aman Dhir, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who on advance notice is present in Court on behalf of the respondent-State, assures the Court that competent authority would look into grievance of the petitioners and legal notice dated 20.11.2024 (Annexure P-7) would be appropriately answered within three months from today.
