1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for quashing of FIR No.0063 dated 14.06.2024, under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC, (offence under Section 326 IPC added subsequently) registered at Police Station Bahawala, District Fazilka (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise/affidavit dated 24.02.2025.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. M. S. Toor, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

4. Mr. Kuljeet Singh, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent Nos.2 to 5 and confirms the factum of the compromise having been effected between the parties and states that respondent Nos.2 to 5 have no objection to the quashing of FIR in question.

5. Learned State counsel has stated no objection in case the FIR is quashed based upon the compromise. He further states that there are no criminal antecedents *qua* the petitioners.



6. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material placed on record.
7. In that view of the matter, even if this case is taken to its logical conclusion, it would only be an exercise in futility as the parties have already settled their differences. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served in wasting the time and resources of the State in pursuing this case to its pre-ordained end. It would, therefore, be better to give a quietus to the issue at this stage.
8. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and FIR No.0063 dated 14.06.2024, under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC, (offence under Section 326 IPC added subsequently) registered at Police Station Bahawala, District Fazilka (Annexure P-1) and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioner shall stand quashed.
9. Needless to say that the parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise.
