1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 24.09.2024 (Annexure P-14) whereby respondent No.3 has dismissed his appeal against order dated 01.02.2021 passed by Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala.

2. The petitioner was part of Punjab Police Force. He sought voluntary retirement in 2022 and his request was acceded to. While in service, he was subjected to punishment of forfeiture of five years service for annual increments vide order dated 01.02.2021 passed by SSP, Patiala. He unsuccessfully preferred appeal before DIG, Patiala Range, Patiala. He has further preferred revision before DGP, Punjab which is still pending.



3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance of the petitioner, at this stage, would be redressed if respondent is directed to decide his revision in a time bound manner.
4. Learned State counsel submits that matter is under active consideration of Director General of Police, Punjab and an appropriate order would be passed within four weeks from today.
5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent to decide revision filed by the petitioner within four weeks from today.
