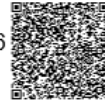

1. Admittedly, there is no decree directing the revenue authority to correct the revenue record. The execution petition filed by the petitioners was disposed of as satisfied on 16.12.2011. Now, the petitioners want that the revenue authorities should correct the revenue record. The Executing Court is bound by decree, however, it cannot travel beyond the decree.
2. Accordingly, no ground to interfere is made out.
