1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is entitled for release of the allowance/emoluments being the Chairman of the Zila Parishad, Moga, from January, 2022 till the date of discharge from duty but the payment is not being released, which is causing prejudice to him.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. T.P.S. Chawla, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.
4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the order dated 15.01.2025 (Annexure P-9) has not been challenged in the present writ petition, vide which though the claim of the petitioner has not been rejected, however, the same is not being implemented due to paucity of funds. Hence, he submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of



as having been not pressed any further with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause of action by challenging the order dated 15.01.2025 (Annexure P-9).
