1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner is praying for issuance of directions to the respondents to consider his case for appointment on the post of Driver/Operator.
2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.3 to decide his representation dated 17.2.2025 (Annexure P-13), in a time bound manner.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Ms. Neha Sonawane, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 and on the asking of the Court, she also accept notice on behalf of respondent No.3. She does not oppose the prayer, as made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.
5. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide his representation dated 17.2.2025 (Annexure

P-13), submitted by the petitioner within a period of 04 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case the claim of the petitioner is declined, reasoned order should be passed, which shall be conveyed to the petitioner.
