By way of present petition filed under Section 482 BNSS, 2023, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under: -

FIR No.	Dated	Sections	Police Station
0460	23.10.2024	406, 420 IPC and 24 of Immigration Act.	Nissing, District Karnal.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 21.05.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. During the course of hearing on 21.05.2025, following order had been passed: -

“ 2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and has



been falsely implicated in this case. He contends that the allegations levelled by the complainant are without any basis.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the petitioner has not allured the complainant in any manner nor defrauded her and hence seeks concession of anticipatory bail.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Praveen Bhadu, Asstt. A.G. Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondent and prays for time to file the status report/reply in the matter. Needful be done well before the date fixed with an advance copy to the counsel opposite.

6. Mr. Shivam Chaudhary, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant to assist the learned State counsel and has filed his vakalatnama. The same is taken on record.

7. Adjourned to 21.05.2025.”

4. Learned State counsel on instructions received from S.I. Surinder Singh informs the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 21.05.2025 passed by this Court, interim



bail granted vide order dated 21.05.2025 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

6. The petition stands allowed.
7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
