KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(ORAL)

1. Both the instant petitions are amenable to be decided together, as the common relief of regular bail has been sought, in case FIR No.176 dated 09.09.2022, under Sections 22 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Tibba, District Ludhina, Punjab, therefore, both the instant petitions are taken up together for adjudication.
2. The custody certificates dated 27.01.2025, qua the petitioner(s),

In both the petitions, furnished by the learned State counsel today in the Court.



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The same are taken on the record. Copy thereof, supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner(s).

3. In deference to the directions issued by this Court, by drawing an order dated 12.11.2024, learned trial Court concerned, has sent status report, which is taken on record.
4. The status report (supra), reflects that the prosecution evidence could not be completed on account of the application filed under Section 311 Cr.P.C., and now, the entire prosecution evidence has been concluded, and only one application under Section 311 of Cr.P.C., is pending consideration for 31.01.2025.
5. It is further mentioned in the status report that likelihood time for the disposal of the instant matter, would take another three months.
6. In view of the above specific report and the fact that since the evidence of all the prosecution witnesses have already been concluded, and only one application under Section 311 Cr.P.C. is pending, which is fixed for hearing on 31.01.2025, therefore, no ground to grant the relief of regular bail to the petitioner(s), is made out.
7. Consequently, both the instant petitions are **dismissed**.
8. Pending applications, if any, stand **disposed of** accordingly.
