1. Through the instant writ petition, cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a mandamus, upon the respondents No.3 to 5, to enter the name of the petitioner in the register of Haryana State Pharmacy Council, and accordingly issue the licence to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents No.4 and 5, has caused appearance, and submits that the original document was submitted by the petitioner only in the month of March, 2025, and therefore, the verification of the document is now required to be done. He further submits that the



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authorities concerned, within a period of two month shall take a final decision, on the application so preferred by the petitioner.

3. In view of the above undertaking given by the learned counsel for respondents No.4 and 5, the instant petition is **disposed of**, by passing a mandamus upon the respondents No.4 and 5, to take a final decision, on the application of the petitioner, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order/judgment.
