The instant petition has been preferred by the petitioner(s) seeking issuance of an appropriate writ especially in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to remove the anomaly in his pay and fix the same at par with pay of his juniors and to release all consequential benefits alongwith interest @18% per annum.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that as regards his grievances mentioned in the petition, the petitioner(s) has already sent a representation dated 03.01.2025 (Annexure P-5) to the respondent(s) and he would be satisfied in case respondent No.2-Commissioner, Gurugram Division, Gurugram, is directed to consider and decide the said representation by passing a well reasoned and speaking order in a time bound manner.

4. Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State and submits that she has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

With the consent of the parties, the present petition is accordingly **disposed of** without commenting on the merits of the present case and with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner, Gurugram Division, Gurugram to take note of the representation dated 03.01.2025 (Annexure P-5) sent by the petitioner and to pass a well reasoned and speaking order thereupon after granting an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties in accordance with law and preferably within a period of 04 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
