1. All these writ petitions are amenable for being decided through a common verdict, inasmuch as the grievance encapsulated in both these writ petitions stems from the inaction on the part of the respondent No.2, who has, despite lapse of considerable time, not made

any decision on the applications submitted by the petitioners for issuance of Registration Certificate of Pharmacist.

2. Learned counsel for respondent no.1, who, on an advance notice, is present in Court, after having instructions from the quarter concerned, informs this Court that within four weeks from today, final decision will be taken on the petitioners' application.

In view of the above submissions, all these writ petitions are **disposed of** with direction upon the respondent No.2 to take a final decision on the petitioners' applications for issuance of Registration Certificate of Pharmacist, within a period of 04 weeks from today. Needless to say, due opportunity of hearing shall be given to the petitioners before drawing the final decision on their applications.
