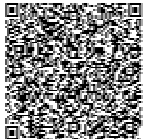

1. The petitioner-College is before this Court praying that in BAMS Course for the Academic Sessions 2024-25, one seat is left vacant on account of dismissal of the petition bearing CWP No.33365 of 2024, titled *Gurpreet Singh v. Guru Ravidas Ayurved University and another* on 20.3.2025 (Annexure P-6), and therefore a direction is sought to allow the petitioner to fill-up the said vacant seat.

2. It is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner that the Course in question with regard to the Academic Sessions 2024-25 has begun in January 2025. It is also not disputed that BAMS Course is of 5 years and 6 months.

3. The process of admission/counseling is over and concluded in



January 2025 and thus cannot be reopened, especially when any student now permitted to be admitted would be unable to fulfill the minimum requisite attendance prescribed for the Course.

4. In view of the above, no case for interference is made out. The petition stands dismissed.
