1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case DDR No.14 dated 06.03.2025 under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 118(2), 191(3), 190 of BNS in FIR No.12 dated 19.02.2025, under Section 109, 118, 115, 191(3), 190, 304 of BNS and Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Begowal, Kapurthala.
2. Vide order dated 30.04.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that pursuant to order dated 30.04.2025, petitioners have joined the investigation and as such their interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Short reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Karnail Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Bholath, District Kapurthala, Punjab has been filed on behalf of respondent-State in the Court, same is taken on record.

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5. Learned State counsel, on instructions, has affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation.

6. In view of the above, interim order dated 30.04.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS.

7. Petition stands allowed.
