The petitioner has approached this Court for seeking issuance of direction to the respondents-UPSC to re-issue the E-Admit Card CS (P) Exam, 2025 to the petitioner against the representation/e-mail dated 16.04.2025.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has been confronted with Section 14 of The Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 which provides that in relation to recruitment, and other matters concerning recruitment, to any All-India Service or to any Civil Service of the Union or a civil post under the Union, the remedy lies before the Central Administrative Tribunal.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to take recourse to the alternative remedy(ies) available to him in accordance with law.
