This is an application filed under Section 528 BNSS, 2023 for placing on record the original affidavit dated 30.07.2025 of respondent No.2/complainant as Annexure P-4.

Application is allowed and affidavit dated 30.07.2025 of respondent No.2/complainant is placed on record.

Main Case

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short-'BNSS') for quashing of FIR No.7 dated 14.01.2025, under Sections 115(2), 117(2), 118(2), 191(3), 190 BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Division A District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent



proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise & affidavit dated 09.04.2025 & 30.07.2025 (Annexure P-2 & P-4).

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Gautam Thapar, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

4. Mr. R. M. Bhaskar, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2-complainant and filed power of attorney on his behalf. The same is taken on record.

5. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondents No.1 and 2 confirm the factum of the compromise having been effected between the parties and states that they have no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question. The original affidavit of the complainant dated 30.07.2025 (Annexure P-4) has been annexed with the main petition.

6. In that view of the matter, even if this case is taken to its logical conclusion, it would only be an exercise in futility as the parties have already settled their differences. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served in wasting the time and resources of the State in pursuing this case to its pre-ordained end. It would, therefore, be better to give a quietus to the issue at this stage.

7. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and FIR No.7 dated 14.01.2025, under Sections 115(2), 117(2), 118(2), 191(3), 190 BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Division A District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners shall stand quashed on the basis of



compromise dated 09.04.2025 (Annexure P-2) and affidavit dated 30.07.2025 (Annexure P-4).
