The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case FIR No.38 dated 24.06.2024 (Annexure P-1) and GD No.34 dated 25.06.2024 (Annexure P-2), registered under Sections 307, 447, 148, 149, 506 of IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act, at Police Station Sadiq District Faridkot.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 06.05.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for further investigation.
