1. This petition has been filed for regular bail under Section 483 of BNSS in case FIR No. 76 dated 11.03.2025 under Sections 22, 27-A of NDPS Act and Section 29 of NDPS Act later on registered at Police Station Civil Line Batala District Gurdaspur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case of the prosecution is that the petitioner has been found in possession of the 70 unlabelled intoxicating tablets. On personal search, Rs. 910/- were recovered from the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 11.03.2025.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Manvir Singh Toor, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate in the Court today, which is taken on record. As per custody certificate dated 07.05.2025 the petitioner is in custody for 01 month and 25 days and he is not involved in any other case. He further submits that FSL report is still awaited and the case is under investigation.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

6. In view of the statement of the learned State counsel, this petition is disposed of. In the meanwhile, the petitioner is granted concession of interim bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds, surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned till the filing of FSL report. When the FSL report is received and challan is prepared, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Court and seek regular bail.
