Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution praying, *inter alia*, for issuance of directions to the official respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No. 6.

2. Although, there is no formal notice of motion in this case; but learned State counsel, on instructions, from ASI Satroop Singh, has apprised the Court that grievance of the petitioner raised through representation dated 17.04.2025 (P-7) has already been examined by the police and same is found to be without any substance due to the reason that allegations are civil in nature.

3. In view of the above, this Court is not inclined to issue any mandate “at this stage”.

4. Consequently, there is no option, except to dispose off the present petition with liberty to petitioner to avail any other remedy as per law, if so advised.

5. Ordered accordingly.
