1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, for issuance of directions to respondent nos.2 & 3 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners and not to interfere in their peaceful life at the behest of respondents No.4 to 6.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that son of the petitioners, namely, Honourjeet Singh was married to Muskan, daughter of respondent no.4 but the said marriage could not survive and there are severe matrimonial differences/disputes between both of them and for this reason, respondent nos.4 to 6 are harbouring a grudge against the petitioners, being in-laws of their daughter Muskan. They apprehend danger from respondent nos.4 to 6. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 22.04.2025 (Annexure P-3) to respondent no.2.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

4. Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

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5. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent no.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sangrur to decide the representation (Annexure P-3) of the petitioners and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived.

6. It is clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.
