CWP-15082-2020 was disposed of vide order dated 22.09.2020, on the statement given by learned counsel representing respondent No.2 therein that the complaint filed by the petitioner had been decided and the order would be communicated within one week.

2. It transpires that no order was communicated to the petitioner and instead, as per the reply submitted to the contempt petition, vide communication dated 27.02.2019, the complaint filed by the petitioner was forwarded to the Deputy Commissioner, Sirsa for information and necessary action.

3. Sh. Sunil Kumar Sharma, learned counsel representing the respondent, submits that pursuant thereto, around 30 acres of land has been got freed from encroachment and as regards other land, litigation is pending before a Division Bench of this Court as a result of which, further action could not be taken. He, however, fairly concedes that the said communication/order was not conveyed to the petitioner and tenders an unconditional apology for the same on behalf of the respondent.



5. This Court is, therefore, of the considered opinion that there has been no willful disobedience of any order.
6. That being so, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
7. The contempt petition is accordingly disposed of. Rule stands discharged. However, the petitioner may, if so advised, avail all such remedies as shall be admissible in law.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
