1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as enshrined under Article 21 of the Constitution of India as they apprehended threat to her life and liberty and her false implication at the hands of private respondents and further directions be issued to respondent No.3 & 4 not to harass and interfere in the life of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the husband of the petitioner is residing abroad and she is staying in the house of her in-laws and she has been harassed by the private respondents and even for two times she was attacked by the private respondents and in this regard, she has filed a complaint/representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, SBS Nagar, Nawanshahar but no action has been taken in this regard.

3. At this stage, Mr. P.S. Bhandari, learned AAG, Punjab submitted

that he has got an advance copy of the present petition and has also sought instructions in the present case. He submitted on instructions from HC Kesar Singh that the matter is being inquired by the DSP and it will be finalized within a period of one month from today after giving an adequate opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the aforesaid statement made by learned State Counsel, he does not wish to press the present petition and prays for withdrawal of the same.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn..
