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HARSH BUNGER, J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of demolition notice dated 15.04.2025 (Annexure P-4), issued by respondent No. 5 (Building Inspector, Zone D, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana).

2. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the petitioner would submit the requisite response and the supporting documents before the concerned authority within a period of 10 days from today.

3. Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel appearing for respondent No. 4 (Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana, Zone D, Ludhiana) have not raised any serious objection for affording another 10 days time to the petitioner to submit his response to the demolition notice dated 15.04.2025 (Annexure P-4), issued by respondent

No. 5 and also to tender documents in support of his claim. They submit that in case any such response to the demolition notice (Annexure P-4) is submitted by the petitioner within a period of 10 days from today, same would be considered in accordance with law and appropriate speaking order thereon would be passed after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner. They further submit that further action on the impugned demolition notice (Annexure P-4) would be deferred for another period of three weeks.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid stand taken by learned State counsel as well as learned counsel appearing for respondent No. 4, the instant civil writ petition is disposed of.

5. Pending application (s), if any, shall also stand closed.
