Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of impugned order dated 04.05.2023 (Annexure P-4) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala, vide which the revision petition filed by the complainant for judicial remand of the petitioner was allowed in case FIR No. 27 dated 21.03.2022 registered under Sections 342, 341, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code (Sections 365 and 325 of IPC added later on) at Police Station Ghanaur, District Patiala.

2. Mr. Aman Mittal, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No. 2 and filed his power of attorney. Same is taken on record.

3. Learned State counsel has filed short affidavit of Varun Sharma, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Patiala, in compliance of order dated 13.02.2025 passed by this Court. Same is taken on record. Be tagged at the appropriate place.
