The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to correct and recalculate the marks awarded to the petitioner in the subject knowledge test dated 23.09.2024 for the post of PGT Mathematics in response to advertisement 28 of 2024, dated 23.07.2024.

2. Learned counsel contended that the petitioner had inspected her answersheet for the test and found that due to wrong calculation of marks, she had been awarded 76 marks, whereas the total actually comes to 81. In case the marks are correctly calculated, she would be entitled to be considered for the selection.

3. On this assertion, Secretary of the Commission was directed to produce the petitioner's original answersheet of the subject knowledge test. The same has been produced today; its perusal shows nothing wrong about calculation of marks awarded by the examinator.



4. In view thereof, there is no ground to entertain the present petition and it stands dismissed *in limine*.
