The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3(1)(d) of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962 for granting parole for a period of 08 weeks to the petitioner as per his entitlement.

The learned State counsel, at the very outset, on instructions from ASI Sarabjit Singh, submits that the case of the petitioner for temporary release in terms of Section 3 of The Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962, is pending consideration with the District Magistrate and a decision would be taken thereon within a period of two months.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.

However, the competent authority is directed to process the application of the petitioner for temporary release within a period of 08 weeks and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law.
