Prayer in the present writ petition is for setting aside the demand notice dated 20.02.2019 for recovery of excess pension made to the petitioner w.e.f. 01.01.2006 to January, 2019 (Annexure P-1) and letter dated 06.07.2019 (Annexure P-3) vide which the request of the petitioner not to make recovery from the pension has been declined. Further prayer has also been made for issuance of directions to the respondents to refund the amount already recovered in pursuance to the letter dated 20.02.2019 along with interest.

On 02.09.2024, learned counsel for the petitioner was confronted with judgments in the matter of **Chaman Lal Vs. State of Punjab & others (CWP-7650-2016) 2022 (3) PLR 489, Parkash Singh Vs. State Bank of India (CWP-18089-2019) 2024 NCPHHC 11953** as well as **Radha Rani Vs. State of Punjab & others, CWP-18693-2021**. Learned counsel accordingly sought time to go through the same and address arguments.

There was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on 13.01.2025 whereupon the matter was adjourned for today. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner today as well. The petitioner is deliberately opting not to address arguments and thus delaying adjudication of the matter.

Accordingly the present writ petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
