The instant contempt petition alleges willful disobedience of order dated 10.01.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed in CWP-2351-2023, vide which the following directions were passed:-

“Be that as it may, in order to ensure that the application of the petitioner is considered, it is directed that the petitioner shall appear in the office of respondent No.4, on 29.01.2024, at 11.00 a.m., along with all the original testimonials and other documents/certificates. In case, respondent No.4, receives the required information from the Sunrise University, Alwar, as well as respondent No.2, and is satisfied with the information received, it shall finally decide the case of the petitioner regarding registration within a period of 4 weeks of the receipt of the communication from the University as well as from respondent No.2. In case, respondent No.4, come to the conclusion that the petitioner cannot be registered and a licence cannot be issued to him under the Act, it shall pass a speaking order giving reasons for rejection.”

2. Compliance report on behalf of the respondent has been filed, as per which, speaking orders dated 09.08.2024 and 18.12.2024 (Annexures R-1 and R-2 respectively) have been passed.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the same, the petitioner does not wish to press the instant petition, at this stage



and shall, if so advised, avail all such remedies as shall be admissible in law against the said speaking orders.

- 4. That being so, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
- 5. The contempt petition is accordingly disposed of. Rule stands discharged.
- 6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
