JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to depute him for Intermediate School Course in order of his seniority. He is further seeking setting aside of guidelines dated 18.05.2018 (Annexure P-8) issued by DGP.

2. The petitioner joined Haryana Police Force on 02.06.2008 as Constable. He passed B-1 test in 2014 and was brought on List 'C' w.e.f. 28.01.2017. He underwent Lower School Course. His name figured at serial No.558 in the final result of Lower School Course. The Disciplinary Authority vide order dated 03.02.2017, on account of misconduct, awarded him punishment of stoppage of two future annual increments with temporary effect. He unsuccessfully preferred appeal as well as revision before the higher authorities. He was promoted as Head Constable vide order dated 05.12.2019, however, w.e.f. 30.06.2019. The



said date was subsequently changed vide communication dated 12.01.2023 and his promotion was made w.e.f. 09.03.2019. The respondent vide communication dated 22.08.2023 3rd time changed his date of promotion and made it effective w.e.f. 03.09.2019. He has not been deputed for Intermediate School Course on account of instructions dated 18.05.2018 (Annexure P-8).

3. On being asked about illegality in the impugned order dated 18.05.2018 (Annexure P-8), learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file afresh with better particulars.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
