SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

This PIL has been filed praying for a direction in the shape of mandamus for removal of illegal encroachment and unauthorized construction raised by respondent No.7, a resident of village Littran, Police Station Tanda, Tehsil Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur, since the said construction causes obstruction in public road connecting the village to main road.

2. After having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perusing the record, it appears that the same matter has been taken up before the Civil Court and certain orders were passed.

3. Accordingly, it appears that the issue essentially relates to title and/or possession of a particular land, which was subject-matter of civil suit(s). This Court is of the considered view that if public land has been obstructed,



the petitioner has a right to raise his grievance before the appropriate authority, which has been done by him by serving legal notice dated 10.03.2025 (Annexure P-13) upon respondents No.2 to 5, which has not been decided as yet.

4. Without going into merits of the case, this Court disposes of the petition with liberty to the petitioner to re-issue legal notice to respondents No.2 to 5, who shall consider and decide the dispute of obstruction on the public land as early as possible by passing a speaking order and communicate the same to the petitioner.
