1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to the official respondents to take appropriate legal action against the actual culprit/accused persons and respondents No.5 and 6.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 15.04.2025 (Annexure P-1) to the Director General of Police Vigilance, Punjab-respondent No.2 and he shall be satisfied at this stage, if directions are issued to respondent No.3 to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. In view of the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed with a direction to respondent No.3- the Senior Superintendent of

Police, District Amritsar Rural, Punjab to look into representation dated 15.04.2025 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate action within two weeks, in accordance with law.
