Petition herein is, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari to set aside orders dated 14.09.2022 (Annexures P-9 and P-10), order dated 23.11.2022 (Annexure P-11), order dated 28.12.2022 (Annexure P-12), *Sanad Takseem* dated 11.01.2023 (Annexure P-13) passed by the learned Assistant Collector, 2nd Grade, Wazirabad, District Gurugram; and also the order dated 27.01.2025 (Annexure P-15) passed by the learned Divisional Commissioner, Gurugram.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that certain relevant documents remain to be annexed with the present writ petition, accordingly, he may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to file fresh one with better particulars and after annexing the requisite documents to demonstrate that Late Smt. Harchandi, from

whom the petitioner claims to have acquired the land by way of re-lease/relinquishment, was recorded as a co-owner of the land under partition in the previous revenue records; as also the revenue records and excerpt (*intekhab*) showing that the other co-sharers, namely Late Smt. Natho, Late Sh. Harchanda and Late Sh. Suberam, had not sold land in excess of their respective shares.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

4. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
