1. The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4, to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family at the hands of respondents No.5 and 6.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, to look into the representation dated 23.04.2025 (Annexure P-7) submitted by the petitioner at the earliest and take appropriate steps as may be required under the law so that his life and liberty may not be jeopardized.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. H.S. Deol, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. In view of the restricted prayer made by learned counsel

for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, to look into the grievance of the petitioner as set out in representation dated 23.04.2025 (Annexure P-7) and take necessary steps at the earliest, if any required, in accordance with law, to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family.
