In the present writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the order dated 29.8.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.1, vide which the petitioner has been wrongly retired from the post of Sewadar. It has also been prayed in the writ petition that a direction be issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 9.9.2024 (Annexure P-7) served by the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to decide her legal notice dated 9.9.2024 (Annexure P-7), in a time bound manner.

4. Mr. Vikas Arora, DAG, Punjab appearing for respondent No.1 and Mr. Jagjot Singh, Advocate appearing for respondents No.2 and 3 do not oppose the prayer, as made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to

respondent No.2 to decide legal notice dated 9.9.2024 (Annexure P-7), submitted by the petitioner within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
