1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, for issuance of directions to respondent no.2 to form a Special Team of police officials of other district or an IPS Officer may be deputed to conduct fair and an impartial inquiry in the complaint filed by the petitioner having UID No.477764 and No.8560-PD dated 27.11.2024/28.11.2024 (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been duped for Rs.7 lacs by respondent nos.4 to 6 for sending him to Poland. He submits that neither the money has been returned by the private respondents nor a valid VISA has been provided to the petitioner, rather a fake VISA was given to him. He further submits that the petitioner has filed various complaints with the police authorities against respondent nos.4 to 6 but no action has been taken against them till date as the police authorities are hand in glove with the private respondents. It is also submitted that respondent nos.4 to 6 are facing multiple criminal proceedings being involved in six FIR cases as is evident from Annexure P-2 and they are habitual offenders but despite

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that, no action is being taken against them on his complaint Annexure P-1 by the official respondents.

3. Notice to the official respondents only.

4. Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and prays for time to have instructions.

5. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent no.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Hoshiarpur to look into the complaint dated 27.11.2024/28.11.2024 (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioner and take action against the erring respondents, in accordance with law, within a period of one month from today.
