1. By way of present writ petition, the petitioner is praying for issuance of direction to the respondents to grant/fix the pension of the petitioner as has already been done in the case of similarly situated employees of respondent No.2 and to release the arrears thereof with effect from 01.04.2024 till date.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although a legal notice dated 04.02.2025 (Annexure P-2) was served upon the respondents and reply has also been given, however, legal notice served by the petitioner was not detailed and relevant facts were also not mentioned. He, on instructions from the petitioner, prays that at this stage, he will be satisfied if

direction is given to respondent No.2 to treat the instant writ petition as a representation and decide the same within a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Vikas Arora, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 3.

5. In view of the facts mentioned above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 that in case the petitioner submits a copy of writ petition, the same may be treated as a representation and be decided within a period of 04 weeks thereafter, in accordance with law. While considering the above said representation, all the contentions raised therein may be considered.

6. The instant writ petition is disposed of in above said terms.
