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HARSH BUNGER, J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondents to renew the passport of the petitioner.

2. In pursuance of advance copy of petition having been served upon respondents No. 1 and 2, Mr. Shivender Pal, Central Government Counsel appears and submits that the petitioner is an accused in case FIR No. 122 dated 24.10.2024. It is further submitted that in the aforesaid case, charges have already been framed against the petitioner and the trial is going on.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner does not dispute the aforesaid fact that trial in case FIR No. 122 dated 24.10.2024 is going on. Accordingly, learned counsel for petitioner prays for withdrawal of this writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Court where the trial is pending, in terms of Notification No. GSR 570-E, dated 23.08.1993, so as to seek permission to depart from India.
