1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to issue No Irregularity Certificate.

2. The petitioner claims that he is going to retire on 31.05.2025 on attaining the age of superannuation. He submitted an application dated 15.04.2025 (Annexure P-20) to the Chairman, Sarva Haryana Gramin Bank, HO, Rohtak for issuance of No Irregularity Certificate, however, till date the same has not been issued.

3. Mr. Anurag Jain, Advocate, who on advance notice is present on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2, assures the Court that competent authority would consider petitioner's claim for No Irregularity Certificate in accordance with law.



4. In the wake of statement of learned counsel for the respondent, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent to consider petitioner’s claim for No Irregularity Certificate in accordance with law within two weeks from today.
