The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to initiate appropriate legal action against respondents No.4 to 6 who have given grievous injuries to the petitioner by entering forcibly in his house.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on 27.02.2025 at around 10:15 P.M., the private respondents entered the house of one Jasbir Kaur whose husband resides abroad and who is related to the petitioner. She made a phone call to her husband who further called the petitioner and asked him and his wife to visit his house to see as to why the private respondents are harassing, abusing and threatened his wife to kill under the influence of liquor. Thereafter, the petitioner and his wife went to the house of Jasbir Kaur at around 10:30 P.M. and asked about the situation, on account of which, uncle of the husband of Jasbir Kaur raised *lalkara* to caught hold the petitioner and his wife to teach them a lesson for coming over to save Jasbir Kaur. On raising *lalkara*, Jodhbir Singh armed with *datar* gave a blow on the middle of head of the petitioner, Balraj Singh armed with *datar* also gave blow on the centre of the head of the petitioner and Jodhbir Singh gave another blow on the head of the petitioner, due to which the petitioner fell down on the ground and blood started oozing. Thereafter, the wife of the petitioner came forward to save him and the accused persons given kick blows to her, thereafter, the petitioner was

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got admitted in the Government Hospital at Baba Bakala on 28.02.2025 and thereafter, moved a representation dated 15.03.2025 (Annexure P-3) for seeking protection of his life and liberty.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 15.03.2025 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab, puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State and copy of the petition has been supplied in the Court.

Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 15.03.2025 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner and take appropriate steps including grant of any protection to the petitioner in view of the apprehension, if any, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
