1. The instant petition has been filed for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for willfully disobeying the order dated 15.07.2024 (Annexure P-1), passed by the Writ Court in CWP-14256-2020, whereby, the following directions were passed:-

“Therefore, this Court is of the considered view that the action of the respondent-Institute being ex facie illegal and without the authority of law which resulted in having a drastic and adverse impact upon the career of a young student, the petitioner deserves exemplary costs in the nature of compensation which are assessed as Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lacs only) which shall be paid to the petitioner by the respondent-Institute within a period of three months from today.”

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.2 & 3 has informed that in compliance of the order dated 15.07.2024, a sum of Rs.2,00,000/- and security amount of Rs.30,000/- has been paid to the petitioner on 04.10.2024. The same has been confirmed by the



petitioner, who is appearing in person. Furthermore, learned counsel, on specific instructions from the respondents, submits that result of the petitioner shall be declared within 10 days from today.

3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking on behalf of the respondents, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is accordingly disposed of.

4. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to file an application for revival of the petition, if the undertaking given aforesaid is not complied with.

5. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
