1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 15.04.2025 (Annexure P-10), passed by respondent No. 3 (District Development and Panchayat Officer, SAS Nagar, Mohali), whereby Shri Joginder Singh, Panchayat Officer, Block Shambu Kalan has been appointed as Administrator under Section 200 of Punjab Panchayati Raj Act for a period of 45 days.

2. In pursuance of advance copy of petition having been served upon respondent-State, Mr. Teevar Sharma, AAG Punjab appears and submits that the order impugned in the instant civil writ petition is appealable and the petitioner has remedy of filing a petition under Section 201 of 1994 Act to challenge the order dated 15.04.2025 (Annexure P-10).

3. In view of aforesaid stand taken by learned State counsel, learned counsel for petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail her remedy of filing an appeal under Section 201 of 1994 Act to challenge the order dated 15.04.2025 (Annexure P-10) before the appropriate authority .

4. Ordered accordingly.
5. In case, any such petition is filed by the petitioner under Section 201 of 1994 Act within a period of one week from today, same shall be considered and decided by the concerned authority within a period of four weeks from the date of filing of the same.
6. Pending application (s), if any, shall also stand closed.
