In compliance of order dated 13.08.2025, the respondent is present in Court. Learned counsel representing the respondent has furnished an affidavit stating that the respondent shall pay the total outstanding amount of Rs.1,40,000/- in 14 equated monthly installments of Rs.10,000/- each. The affidavit dated 26.08.2025 is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

In response, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, the petitioner does not wish to press the present contempt petition in view of the categorical undertaking submitted in Court by way of an affidavit. However, it is prayed that in the event of any violation of the undertaking, liberty be granted to the petitioner to move a revival application or to avail all such other remedies as shall be admissible in law.

In view of the statements made by learned counsel for the parties, the present contempt petition is disposed of in terms thereof.
