SANJAY VASHISTH, J (ORAL)

1. On 05.05.2025, following order was passed:-

“1. Present petition under Section 528 read with Section 529 of BNSS, 2023 has been filed for seeking direction to the learned trial Court Dera Bassi, Mohali for expeditious disposal of CHA-6-2024, titled as State of Deepa Singh, arising out of FIR No.0142 dated 26.12.2019, under Section 66A, 66D and 66E of Information Technology Act, 2008, at Police Station Dhakoli.

2. By referring to zimni orders dated 06.04.2024, 09.05.2024, 31.08.2024, 07.11.2024, 07.12.2024, 22.04.2025 counsel contends that despite making compliance under Section 207 Cr.P.C on 22.04.2025, more than 01 year has passed but trial Court/learned JMIC, Dera Bassi/Mohali has not proceeded with the case for any material purpose.

3. Let, reasons of delay in the proceedings be called from the concerned Magistrate, with regard to the submission addressed by the petitioner, through zimni orders appended with the petition.

4. List on 14.07.2025.”

2. Today, on the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that present petition can be disposed of, as having been rendered

infructuous, as the discharge application, which was the subject matter of the present proceedings, has already been decided and dismissed by learned Trial Court.

3. In view of the statement made by counsel for the petitioner today before this Court, present petition is disposed of, as the same having been rendered infructuous.
