Petition herein is, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside orders dated 23.06.2022 (Annexure P-2) passed by the learned Assistant Collector, 1st Grade, Kanina; order dated 12.07.2023 (Annexure P-3) passed by the learned Collector, Sub Division Kanina; and order dated 03.05.2024 (Annexure P-5) passed by the learned Divisional Commissioner, Gurugram.

2. A perusal of file reveals that on the last date of hearing, i.e. 21.07.2025, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“A perusal of order sheets reveals that on the last date of hearing, i.e. 09.07.2025, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“At request of learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, adjourned to 21.07.2025.

It is made clear that no further adjournment shall be afforded and in case, counsel for the petitioner is in some difficulty on the next date of hearing, the alternate arrangement should be made, so as to assist the Court in the matter, otherwise, consequential orders would be passed in the matter.”

However today again, a request for adjournment has been made by learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, which is totally unjustified.

*At his request, adjourned to 20.08.2025, subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- to be deposited with “**Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association Lawyers' Family Welfare Fund (Account No.41564846387, S.B.I. High Court Branch)**”.*

3. As per office report, no fresh document/receipt as regards the payment of costs of Rs.10,000/-, has been filed by learned counsel for the petitioner.
4. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner today. It appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present matter any further.
5. Keeping in view the above, the present writ petition is dismissed for non-prosecution as well as for non-compliance of order dated 21.07.2025 passed by this Court.
6. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
