1. The petitioner is seeking cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent No.2 by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Kapurthala vide order dated 20.12.2023 (Annexure P-1) in case FIR No.65 dated 03.04.2022 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 201, 379, 447, 120-B of the IPC registered at Police Station City Kapurthala.

2. Status report by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Kapurthala, on behalf of the respondent-State has been filed in the Court today, which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions. A copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

3. Learned State counsel, at the outset, has drawn the attention of this Court to paragraph 7 of the affidavit and has submitted that the matter stands amicably settled between the parties and a compromise dated 25.03.2025 has already been executed between them in the presence of the witnesses.



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4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties and the present petition be disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
