The instant petition has been originally filed by two petitioners namely, Vijay Kumar and Meena Devi, assailing the judgment of conviction and order on quantum of sentence dated 12.03.2012 in case arising FIR No.381 dated 26.06.2005 registered under Sections 323 and 326 read with Section 34 of the IPC, at Police Station Kotwali, District Bathinda, whereby, the petitioners had been held guilty and convicted for commission of offences under Sections 325 and 326 IPC read with Section 34 of IPC as well as the judgment dated 17.12.2013 passed in CrI. Appeal No.779 of 2013 as passed by the learned First Appellate Court.

2. Petitioner No.2 has been expired during the pendency of revision petition. Vide separate order of even date passed in CRM-M-32435-2024, the aforementioned FIR had been ordered to be quashed by this Court and in

view of this fact, the present revision petition has been rendered infructuous.
