1. This is the first petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.118 dated 06.05.2023 registered under Sections 302/34 IPC (Section 201 IPC added and Section 34 IPC deleted later on) at Police Station Sadhaura, District Yamuna Nagar (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition and submits that the petitioner is behind the bars since 08.05.2023 and the FIR (supra) was registered on 06.05.2023 and in spite of passing of 20 months, the prosecution has failed to conclude its evidence.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that out of 27 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 14 have been examined and all efforts would be made by the prosecution to produce all its witnesses for the expeditious disposal of the trial.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, learned trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously preferably within a period of six months.
