The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release arrears of salary due to pay hike in a time bound manner, in view of judgment dated 30.09.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-14904-2024 titled *Dr. Dusyant and others v. State of Haryana and another*.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case she is permitted to make a fresh representation before the respondents raising the grievance as has been raised in this petition, and the same may be ordered to be decided within a



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specified period.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State, and submits that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner within a period of two weeks, the same will be decided by the second respondent-Director General, Higher Education, by passing a speaking/reasoned order thereupon in accordance with law, within a period of three months of receiving the representation.
5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
6. Ordered accordingly.
7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
