The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to arrest the respondent No.4, who has been declared proclaimed person on 23.12.2024 in a complaint case bearing No. NACT-531/2023 dated 10.08.2023, titled as "*Paramjit Singh Vs. Mariya*".

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 15.02.2025 (Annexure P-3) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkotla, District Malerkotla-respondent No.2 and he shall be satisfied at this stage, if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed with a direction to respondent No.2- the Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkotla, District Malerkotla, to look into representation dated 15.02.2025 (Annexure P-3) and take appropriate action within two weeks, in accordance with law.
