By way of the present writ petition, the petitioners have sought issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the official respondents to restrain them from uprooting and demolishing Jhuggis in Kumhar Colony, Sector-25D, Chandigarh and the applicants who have been found eligible for allotment of Plinth Sites in terms of order /Award dated 31.12.2019 (Annexure P-1) passed by Permanent Lok Adalat (Public Utility Services), Union Territory, Chandigarh.



2. It was pointed out by the learned counsel for the respondents that matter is already subjudice before the learned Single Bench in CWP-21464-2024. It has further been pointed out that the order passed by the Permanent Lok Adalat i.e. Annexure P-1 under which the petitioners claim their entitlement has been stayed in the above-mentioned writ petition.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners prays for permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to appear in the above-referred writ petition and make necessary applications for redressal of their grievance.

4. In view of above, present writ petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

5. It is noted that observations made hereinabove should not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
