Learned counsel appearing for respondents No.2 to 4 submits that the disability certificated (Annexure P/8) has not been brought to the notice of the authorities concerned and was also not attached with the admission form so as to grant consideration to claim of the petitioner-child for admission under the Differently-Abled (General) category. Learned counsel for the respondents No.2 to 4 submits that as the disability certificate has been attached with the present petition as Annexure P/8, the claim of the petitioner-child for admission in 1st Class for the Session 2025-26 under the Differently-Abled (General) category will be considered and in case, any vacancy is available, the petitioner-child will be considered against the said vacancy and appropriate action will be taken within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for respondents No.2 to 4, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
